## B. **Trainings, Meetings, Presentations**

Cathay attended the TEDX in Wilmington on Wednesday, August 7. Twenty-four authors, motivational speakers, business and community leaders gave presentations on a wide range of topics. Most of the speakers were from the area.

Chat, email and liaison training was offered at Brandywine Hundred on Thursday August 15 and again at Woodlawn on Friday, August 23.

Testing of video conferencing equipment took place throughout the month, to prepare for the September 12 meeting and for use beyond that. Dover Public Library, DDL, Seaford and Georgetown Job Centers/Small Business Centers collaborated.

Adobe Connect webinar software was tested this month.

The School Partnership Committee worked on the Class Visit Toolkit for the development of a way to promote the planning of class visits using Ask a Librarian Delaware. It is to be completed in mid-September.

Cathay met with Lauri McIntosh, OCLC-QuestionPoint Product Manager, in Newark on Wednesday August 21<sup>st</sup> to discuss Delaware's needs with the use of QP for Ask a Librarian DE.

Cathay attended the Affordable Care Act Stakeholders Meeting at DelTech/Stanton on Wednesday and has been involved in online webinars and discussions throughout the month. Among some of the preparations, a workshop is scheduled for Delaware Reference Services Group on October 3.

<b>300</b>	<b>Social Sciences</b> (education, law, financial, veterans, government, politics, folklore questions)
<b>400</b>	<b>Language</b> (ESL, grammar, and literacy questions)
<b>500</b>	<b>Science</b> (STEM*, mathematics, physics, chemistry, zoology, botany, earth sciences, paleontology, evolution, dinosaurs)
<b>600</b>	<b>Applied Science</b> (technology, health, engineering, pets, cooking, management, job hunting, home building and construction questions)
<b>700</b>	<b>Arts/Sports</b> (fine arts, architecture, home decorating, photography, music, recreation/ sports questions)
<b>800</b>	<b>Literature</b> (questions about fiction including readers' advisory questions)
<b>900</b>	<b>History and Geography</b> (genealogy, travel, and biography)
