Join Elizabeth Duffy of collectionHQ and Bob Wetherall of DDL for a refresher on the use of collectionHQ. The new CHQ interface, Version 4.0, to be introduced on August 18, will be explained. The main purpose of collectionHQ is to help you keep your shelves up-to-date with titles your patrons will want to borrow. While our holds system is very efficient, a recent study shows that over 80% of your circulation is a result of patrons browsing your shelves. collectionHQ can help you keep these shelves filled with the titles your patrons want. It can also help you market your collection effectively. As before, the workshop is geared to library staff directly involved in the selection of materials for their libraries.
