D. Patron comments for December, 2012

I decided to show something a little different through our surveys. Out of the 16 surveys from Delaware patrons, only one offered a positive comment: "Was very helpful and answered my question right away."

Since comments were scarce, I thought it might be more helpful to look at some of the details of the surveys. Surveys asked for patron feedback on staff quality, if the question was answered and how the patron felt about the level of answer received. I also included information about whether the patrons used this for the first time or not.

It's wonderful to see that the majority of December's patrons were first-time users of our chat service and that they found this to be an excellent experience. One patron indicated a poor experience. Let's look into that a little more (see below the table).

The negative survey offered in December shows important patron feedback about the expectation of obtaining an answer in chat (in the 'place' the patron chose), not to be sent away to call or visit the library in person.

When I reviewed the transcript I saw that the librarian was from another state, assisting our patrons since no Delaware librarians were available for chat. The patron's question was "How do I put a book on hold and get a PIN?" The chatting librarian did not check the policy pages for PIN retrieval information and missed the opportunity to help with instructions about how to place a hold. She directed the patron to call the library and set the question to "Answered" instead of offering to the patron a way for us to get back to him/her (obtaining an email address and setting the resolution code to "follow up by patron's library").

Through our diligence and excellent service, we're able to get back to our patrons in a timely and friendly manner and usually do! We have a PIN retrieval policy and we tell our patrons to expect a response within a couple of regular business days (if they opt for that and provide contact info).

(For this transcript, I sent in a Quality Review through QuestionPoint.)

Another comment that came in December shows how polite our Delaware patrons can be! --

"I sent this at 0521 am, not wantingto wake anybody, I closed the seesion so they could reply via email. the answer to my question doesnt have to be right at this moment"

All in all, patrons have been very satisfied with the quality of Ask a Librarian Delaware and their experience using it!
