

## Assigning Event Types

Please use the following list when assigning Event Types. Classifying events in this fashion will help in tracking events by subject.

Computer programs, programs about e-books, use **Computers/E-Books (000)**

Self-help programs, use **Self-help (100)**

Programs about world religions, use **World Religion (200)**

Programs centering on education, law, finance, veterans, government, use **Social Services (300)**

Programs concerning literacy, English as a second language, Paws to Read, use **Literacy/Language (400)**

STEM programs (science, technology, engineering, and mathematics), use **Science (500)** if the program emphasizes pure science or mathematics

STEM programs (emphasizing technology or engineering), use **Applied Science (600)**

Health related programs, gardening, business and management, pets, cooking, use **Applied Science (600)**

Job training programs, use **Job Training/Careers (600)**

Fine arts programs, interior decorating, arts and crafts programs, gaming programs, or recreation and sports programs, use **Arts/Crafts (700)**

Author talks, book discussions, programs on readers' advisory, use **Book Discussion/Literature (800)**

Story times, use **Story Time (800)**

History, genealogy, and travel programs, use **History/Genealogy (900)**

Events that do not concern a specific subject, such as a book sale, use **Meeting/Reserved**
