**C. Trainings, Meetings, Presentations**

1. A new staff training was held in Dover (Public Archives, Training Center) on October 2. This included public and law libraries.
2. Cathay was on WILM Radio (with Bruce Elliott) promoting Ask a Librarian Delaware and our Delaware libraries on Friday, October 5.

3. Cathay attended the QuestionPoint Advisory Board meeting on Friday, October 5, which was mostly centered on the software changes (starting with the Qwidget). Notes and screenshots were sent to the Ask a Librarian Delaware list after the meeting.
4. Cathay attended a Virtual Reference Collaborative meeting on Monday, October 22. Some coordinators of state virtual reference services are with QuestionPoint and others use different software – all share ideas.
5. Email training (and chat) was provided at Hockessin Branch library on Thursday, October 25, in preparation for the switch of the current Request Module to a webform in QuestionPoint.
6. Hurricane Sandy hit our region on October 29 and 30, and libraries were closed. This also caused the email training in Georgetown to be rescheduled (for Tuesday, November 20).

**D. Upcoming:**

Email training - in preparation for QP email training – is scheduled for November 20 at the Georgetown Public Library.

Cathay will participate in the Train-the-Trainer Turning the Page 2.0 program in Chicago during the first week of November.

The next Quarterly Liaison Meeting is set for Thursday, November 15, 2012 at the new Dover Public Library, at 1-3pm.

- 200**      **Religion**
- 300**      **Social Sciences** (education, law, financial, veterans, government, politics, folklore questions)
- 400**      **Language** (ESL, grammar, and literacy questions)
- 500**      **Science** (STEM\*, mathematics, physics, chemistry, zoology, botany, earth sciences, paleontology, evolution, dinosaurs)
- 600**      **Applied Science** (technology, health, engineering, pets, cooking, management, job hunting, home building and construction questions)
- 700**      **Arts/Sports** (fine arts, architecture, home decorating, photography, music, recreation and sports questions)
- 800**      **Literature** (questions about fiction including readers' advisory questions)
- 900**      **History and Geography** (genealogy, travel, and biography)
