Topics

-easy way to determine helpful subjects and info

- What questions do you get on the desk and in chat?
- What resources do you normally use?*

*resources = existing Delaware library materials (physical and online)

Topics - Example

Let's say you get questions about how to start up a new business. In the reference conversation, your patron lets you know that she is:

- Concerned about competition
- Doesn't know about how to legally set up a new business ("What's involved with that?")

You help her, and in doing so think...

"Hey! This would be a good resource for others!"
