- In process of purchasing additional workstations & Laptops

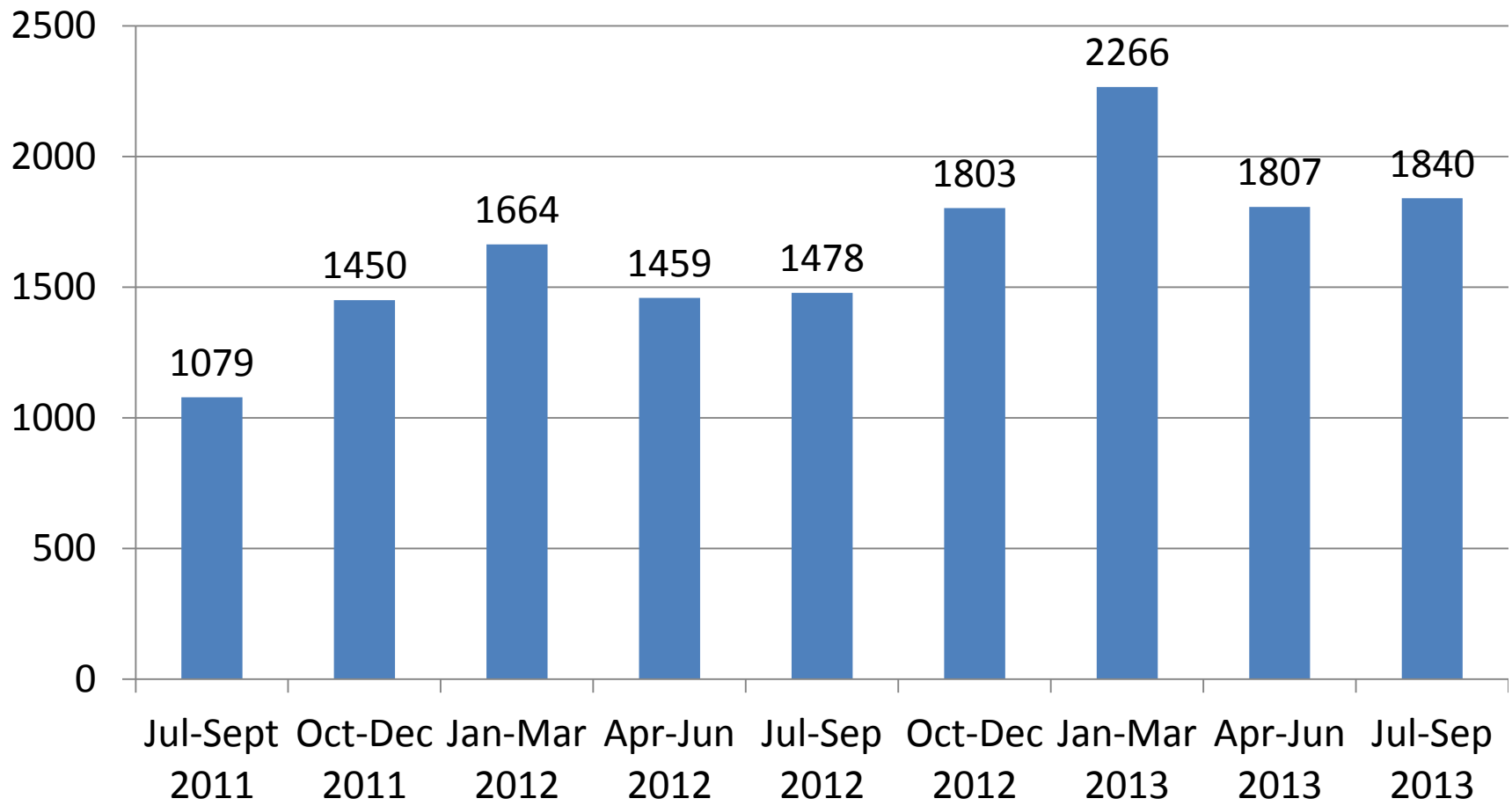
Wireless Service:

- Now available at all public libraries in DE.

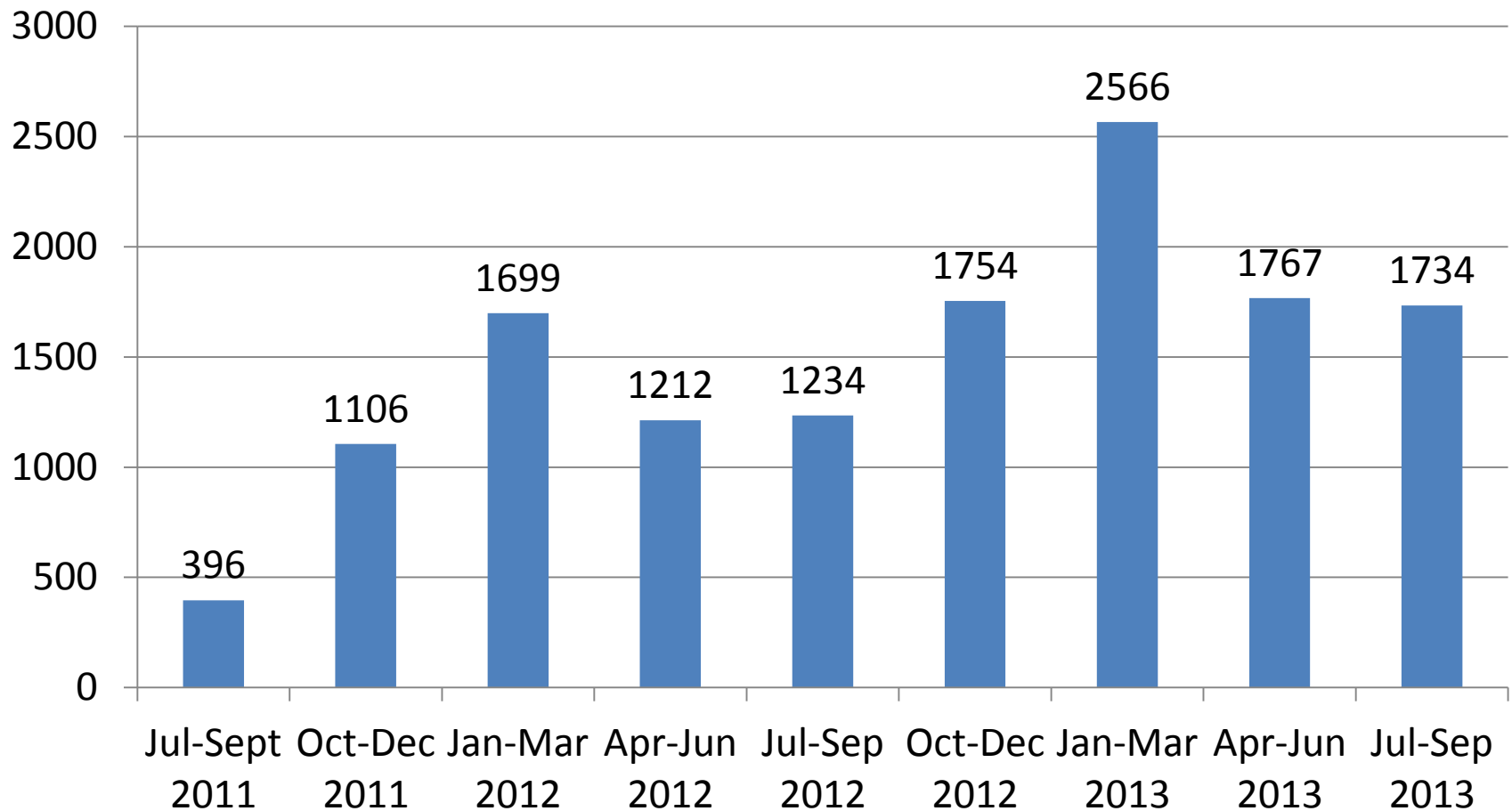
Video Conferencing:

- 5 large units and 28 smaller units have been installed. Purchasing 2 more large units

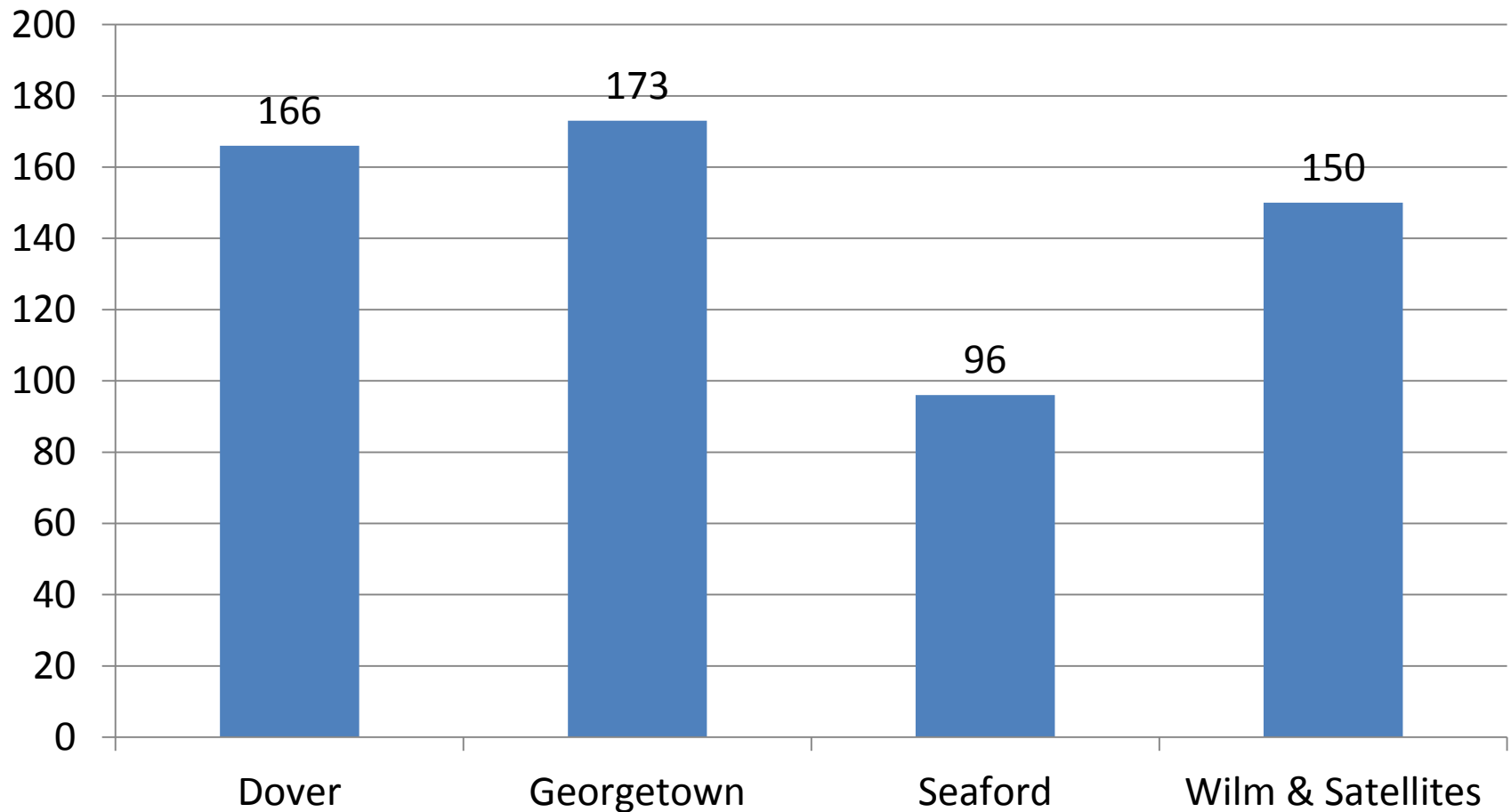
Job Center Patron Visits
