

Affordable Connectivity Program

A **benefit program** that is offered to low-income households. Two benefits:

- A monthly discount of \$30 towards internet service (\$75/mo if on tribal land)
- One-time \$100 credit towards the purchase of a digital device (Laptop, Desktop, Tablet). At least \$10 must be contributed, but less than \$50.

Who Are Eligible

- Households that fall 200% or below the federal poverty line
- Individuals that already receive other benefits such as SNAP, WIC, Medicaid
- Houseless individuals can still qualify for the ACP benefit
- Undocumented individuals are eligible to be qualified

- Individuals will need to fill out the forms with their personal information
- Individuals will need to upload a form of Government ID and/or SSN
 - Driver's License, Passports, Military License, and Tribal ID are all acceptable
- Following the pre-enrollment, individuals must record their **Application ID Number**.
- Once the application is complete, they will need to wait to see if their application status is approved
- Following approval, the individual must contact the service provider and give them their Application ID number. The \$30 monthly credit is sent directly to the service provider, not the individual. Individuals may sign up for a new provider but must cancel their existing service if their provider does not participate in the program. Major companies like FIOS and Comcast participate.
- For the one-time \$100 device discount, it must be purchased through a provider. Service providers list <https://www.fcc.gov/affordable-connectivity-program-providers>
