# **Social Innovation Team Updates:** Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) application process – Alta Porterfield

What is it? Federal program, DE State pilot in 5 cities: Dover, Georgetown, Milford, Seaford, & Wilmington. For eligible households to receive \$30/month credit towards internet service costs and \$100 towards a device. Residents can sign up even if they are not in the pilot program areas.

#### Monthly statistics - Number of unique tickets in April 2023: 241
