Business Reference Updates – Janet Wurtzel

The ALA LBB (Libraries Build Business) work group published a couple of guides to support the creation of an entrepreneurship program.

- <u>LBB Playbook</u> is a step-by-step guide to engaging the business and economic development organizations in your community and finding a role for the library within the group. It includes examples of successful programming from libraries across the county of every size in highly urban to very rural communities.
- ALA LBB recently published a second guide, a <u>Communications Toolkit</u> to generate awareness and engagement in your entrepreneurship program to four audiences: Business Support Organizations; Small Business Owners; Elected Officials, Funders and Community Decision Makers; and Library Staff. Specific messaging templates are included for emails, PowerPoint presentations and flyers along with talking points. These resources are free to all public libraries.
