- **Licensing Requirements and Records: Bare Minimum Requirements** Our provider reports have a link that takes parents directly to licensing reports.
- **Quality Improvement System:** Delaware Stars is being revamped. A voluntary program used to improve and communicate the level of quality in early care and education and school-age settings.
- **Accreditation:** National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC) Accreditation, National Accreditation Commission for Early Care and Education Programs (NAC), National Association for Family Childcare Association.



Visit providers:

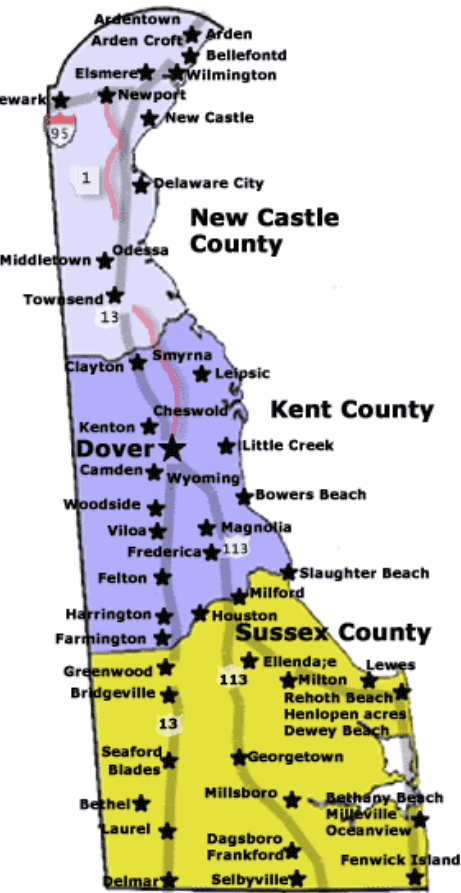
- Observe physical space/environment
- Observe provider/child interactions
- Observe learning materials

Ask Questions:

- How does the provider communicate with parents?
- What is daily schedule?
- Staff educational level?
